Work commitments have kept David away from Savoyards for quite some time but tonight he returns to stage as Rudi.

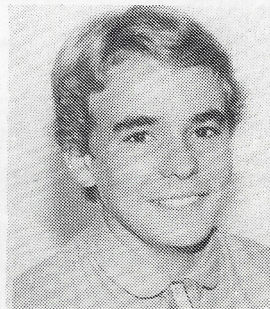
Len Wells

The General is not pleased when he discovers that his daughter has agreed to marry Sou-Chong, but he allows it so as not to cause trouble.

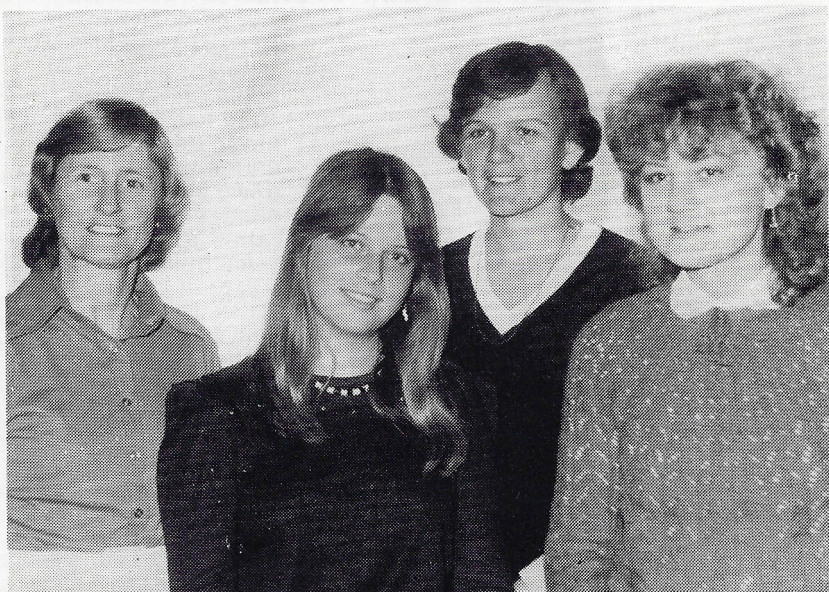
Lisa and Sou-Chong then depart leaving a heartbroken Gustl behind.

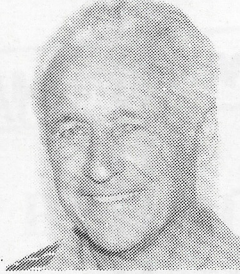

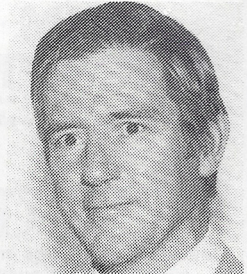
