Miranda Selwood holds a Bachelor of Music Theatre from the Central Queensland Conservatorium of Music. having come from a decade of dance training. She has extensive experience as a performer in community and semiprofessional productions in Brisbane including: Miss Adelaide in Blue Fish Theatrical's Guys and Dolls, Eliza Doolittle in Savoyards' My Fair Lady, Mrs Lovett in Ignatians' Sweeney Todd, Reno Sweeney in Savoyards' Anything Goes and The Witch in Ignatians' Into The Woods. More recently Miranda has become known for her work as a Director, including Avenue Q and Little Shop of Horrors for the Brisbane Arts Theatre, and Spamalot and the awardwinning production of Shrek: The Musical for PRIMA. She is especially proud of her directorship of Ignatians' Little Women in 2013.

Under the banner of Mirthful Productions, Miranda is the Producer of The 24 Hour Musical Project, which is looking to its fifth year as a milestone community fundraising venture. Miranda has a true appreciation of the pure joy of the Broadway Musical and a special place in her heart for 42nd Street (the movie, the musical and the place).

Peter Allen led a colourful and spirited life, and I'm so pleased to be bringing life to an all new Savoyards' production of his story, *The Boy From Oz*.

This musical biography and tribute to Peter Allen is written as a Vegas-style cabaret, telling his story through his own music and lyrics. The effective and clever script leaps back and forth from past to present; between a concert where Peter speaks directly with the audience, reflecting on his extraordinary life, and flashbacks featuring a full cast of friends, family, lovers and mentors who inspired him along the way. #### MUSICAL DIRECTOR

#### BENJAMIN TUBB-HEARNE

Benjamin Tubb-Hearne is originally from London, UK and studied Tenor Horn and Composition at the Royal Northern College of Music. Ben moved to New York City. where his Musical Direction journey began at the French Woods Summer Camp. Here he musically directed and conducted over 20 shows, including Annie, A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum, Curtains and Sweet Charity. It was also here that Ben, with writing partner Ryan Jacobs, created 1 hour musical versions of popular movies for children including *Toy* Story, Enchanted and A Bug's Life, as well as creating their own superhero musical Powers. In 2014 Ben & Ryan's original full-length musical Twisted, a story which follows Little Blue Riding Hood's search to find her real family, premiered at the Playhouse Theatre at French Woods to much acclaim, and it is currently preparing for a second workshop.

Although Ben is relatively new to Brisbane he has burst onto the scene musically directing *The King and I* & Chicago (Savoyards), Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, La Cage Aux Folles, Big Fish, Young Frankenstein and Beauty and the Beast (Phoenix Ensemble).

As a Brit, when I was approached to musically direct *The Boy From Oz*, I must admit I didn't know much about it. I did some research, listened to his songs and watched a few documentaries about the life of Peter Allen, and from that point, it was clear that he was a very special man.

The Boy From Oz may be, on its surface, an upbeat, maracashaking, patriotic Australian jukebox musical, but once you delve in a little deeper you discover that there are so many hard-hitting issues tackled. It was for these reasons that I was so excited to take on this challenge. From the death of his father to the Stonewall riots, this musical is not afraid to show the darker side of his life - something that could easily be shied away from with a bit of glitter and fabulous costumes.

I have to thank my amazing creative team and my fantastic assistant Matt for being wonderful throughout this whole process. The cast have been amazing from start to finish and I'm sure they'll forgive me for the highest soprano part in 'Pretty Keen Teen'!

Sit back and enjoy the fabulous life of Peter Allen.





## PETER ALLEN SHANNON

Shannon, born in Townsville, studied at the Queensland Conservatorium of Music and Royal College of Music, London.

In 1999 he was Young artist with Opera Queensland, then while studying at the Royal College of Music London, he performed the roles Theseus in *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, Pilate in Brockes *Passion*, The Messenger in *Oedipus Rex*, Betto in *Gianni Schicchi*, Dulcamara in *L'elisir d'amore*, Mr Gedge in *Albert Herring*, Pallante in *Agrippina*, and Papageno in *The Magic Flute*.

Shannon debuted with Opera Australia in 2003 with such roles as Papageno in *The Magic Flute*, Marchese in *La Traviata*, Schaunard in *La Bohème* and Belcore in *L'elisir d'amore*.

In 2007 as a soloist for Cologne Opera, Germany his roles included Achilla in *Julius Caesar*, Haly in *The Italian Girl in Algiers*, Hermann in *The Tales of Hoffmann* and Hauptmann in *Rotter*.

Shannon returned to Australia in 2008 to perform in Opera Australia's production of Britten's *Billy Budd*.

In 2018, after almost a 10 year performance hiatus, Shannon sang Jean Valjean in Savoyards' production of *Les Misérables*. Most recently he performed Captain Von Trapp for the 24 Hour Musical Production's *The Sound of Music* and Dr Dillamond in *Wicked* for Matt Ward Productions on the Gold Coast.

## BIOCBYDHA

- **1944 -** Born Peter Woolnough, 10 February, Tenterfield, NSW. Grows up in Armidale.
- **1948 -** Begins playing piano, self-taught. Later has lessons.
- 1955 Becomes regular entertainer at the local pub: The New England Hotel.
- 1959 Meets Chris Bell in Surfers Paradise, QLD. The duo are dubbed "The Allen Brothers".
- 1960 The Allen Brothers achieve national exposure on TCN 9's Bandstand.
- **1962 -** The Allen Brothers tour Asia and decide to stay on.
- 1964 Meet Judy Garland during Hong Kong visit. She flies The Allen Brothers to London, where Peter becomes engaged to Garland's daughter Liza Minnelli.
- 1967 Marries Liza Minnelli in New York
- **1969 -** Death of Judy Garland. Final performance of the Allen Brothers in Florida.
- 1970 Peter Allen and Liza Minnelli separate. The Allen Brothers officially break up. Peter decides his future lies in song writing.
- **1971 -** Releases first solo album as singer-songwriter. Returns to Australia for Bandstand TV reunion show. Writes song *Tenterfield Saddler* while staying with his mother in Bondi, NSW.
- **1972 -** Releases second solo album: *Tenterfield Saddler*. Makes Los Angeles debut as opening act to Bette Midler.

- **1977 -** *I Go To Rio*, hit record, leads to concerts at the Paris Olympia and the Sydney Opera House. Profiled on Australian TV's 'This is Your Life'.
- **1979 -** Broadwaydebutinconcert-style presentation 'Up In One'. Tours Los Angeles, Melbourne and Sydney
- **1980 -** Writes *I Still Call Australia Home*. Launches sell-out season at the Copacabana. Performs at the Sydney Opera House Royal Command Performance on 27 May.
- 1981 Manager Dee Anthony negotiates two hit concert seasons at the Radio City Music Hall, New York.
- **1982 -** Wins Best Song Oscar as co-writer of theme to the movie *Arthur*.
- **1983 -** Performs at the Gala Opening Concert, Sydney Entertainment Centre, on 1 May.
- **1984 -** Plays seven concerts at Carnegie Hall in New York.
- 1985 Writes Broadway musical Legs Diamond.
- **1988** Australian concert bill with Frank Sinatra and Whitney Houston at Sanctuary Cove. Opens in Broadway show *Legs Diamond*, singing self-written score.
- **1990 -** Releases final album, *Making Every Moment Count*.
- **1992** Begins Australian tour which is cut short. Gives final performance on 26 January in Sydney. Dies 18 June at Mercy Hospital, San Diego, California.
- **1998 -** Thursday, 5 March World Premiere: *The Boy From Oz* stage musical, Sydney, Australia.
- **2003 -** Thursday, 16 October Broadway Premiere: *The Boy From Oz* stage musical, New York City, USA








#### YOUNG PETER ALLEN


## VANESSA WAINWRIGHT
