#### A WEE BIT ABOUT BRIGADOON

Thus begins the musical play "Brigadoon." Here is a story designed for the enjoyment of young and old alike. No sooner have the house lights dimmed, the orchestra struck the opening strains emulating the pipes and the choral ensemble sung the words above, then the curtain rises on the two American hunters, who are lost in a forest in Scotland. As the sun rises, Tommy Albright discovers through the mist, an unchartered villiage, and calling to his cynical friend, Jeff Douglas, to follow, they soon arrive in quaint "Brigadoon." Here Tommy meets Fiona MacKeith and their love story commences. 
