JOHANNA TOIA ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

Johanna Toia is the third generation of her family to tread the boards, joining Savoyards as a dancer in the company's production of The Merry Widow in 1965. She went on to perform in a range of operettas and musicals in chorus, minor and major principal roles. Many years of experience in all aspects of performing and production combined with her love of musical theatre made her transition into directing an obvious one.

She began her directing career with South Pacific (Co-Director) and going on to be part of creative teams as assistant director for Savoyards productions of Cabaret (2007); 42nd Street (2010) and as director for Oklahoma! (2005); H.M.S Pinafore (2007); My Fair Lady (2011); Thoroughly Modern Millie (2014); Legally Blonde (2016); The King and I (2017) and Hot Shoe Shuffle (2021).



NICKY GRIFFITH musical director

Nicky Griffith is a conductor, multiinstrumentalist and music teacher. She is the Assistant Conductor of Queensland Youth Orchestras and directs the highly accomplished Strings Program at Varsity College.

Since 2012, Nicky has contributed to over forty musical theatre productions in South-East and North Queensland. In 2022, she musically directed and conducted Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street (Phoenix Ensemble), Charlie and the Chocolate Factory (HOTA), and was assistant musical director for Les Misérables (Lynch & Paterson) and assistant conductor for The Pirates of Penzance (Lynch & Paterson). Nicky was musical director and conductor of Hot Shoe Shuffle (Savoyards) in 2021 and assistant musical director and guest conductor of Oklahoma! (Savoyards) in 2019.

With formal training in jazz, tap, classical (Sue Harvey Academy of Modern Stage Dance) and Polynesian dance (Isles of the Pacific Polynesian Dance Troupe), Desney is no stranger to the stage.

JACQUELINE ATHERTON ROSIE


